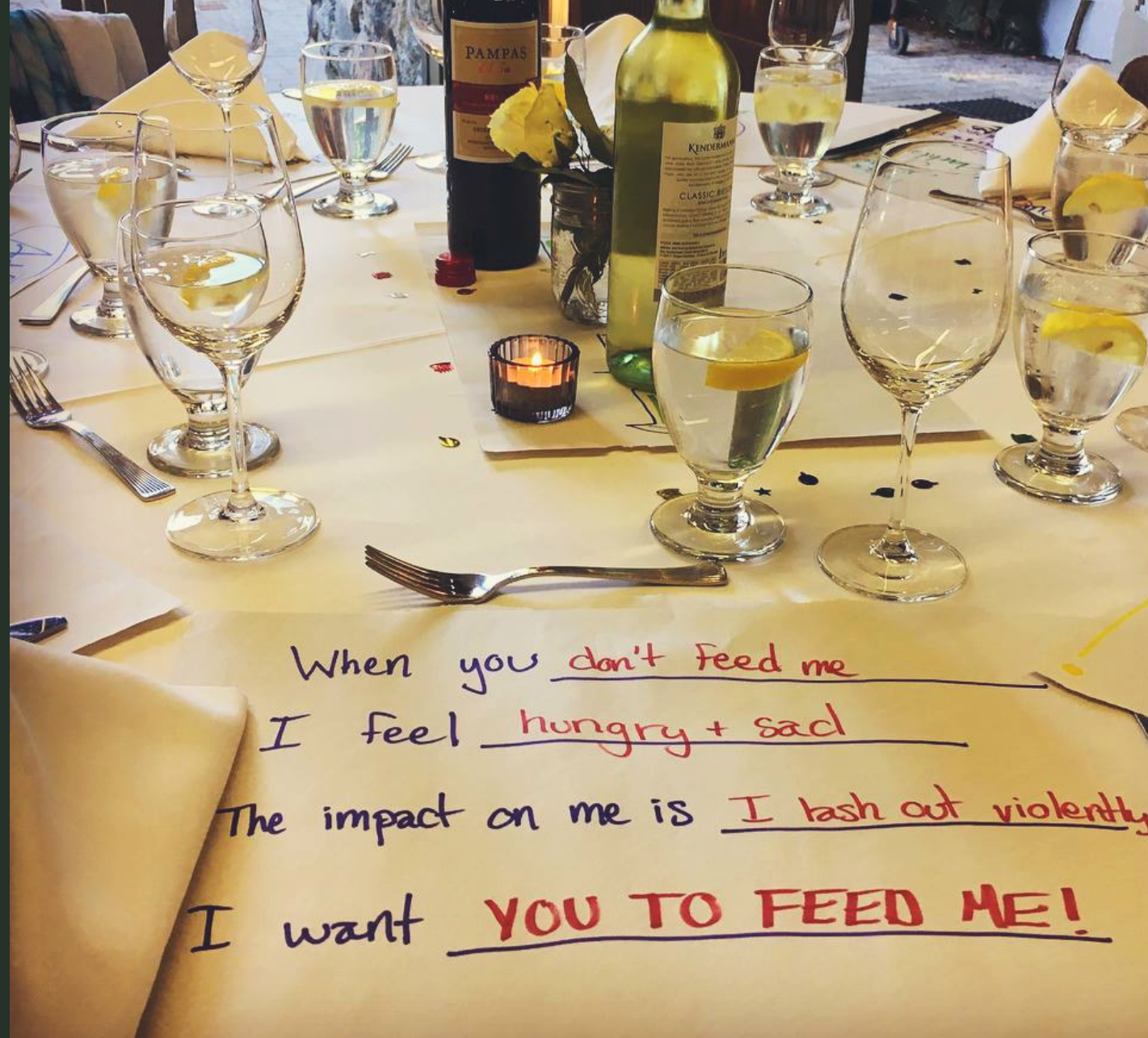


Ottawa School for Parish Development

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The School forms leaders to

- Look at the current reality and ask: Who are we? Where are we?
- Discern the future: What is God calling us to be in this time and place?
- Work on plans to get to the future: How do we get there?

Who?

Clergy and lay people. Ideally, a team representing a parish rather than individuals

Cost?

The program costs \$1000/person/year: \$500 from the Diocese and \$500 from the student (or student's parish).

How?

Through a combination of plenary, case studies, and small group work, learn to offer and receive feedback, identify organizational change process, understand trust development, manage conflict, and sharpen facilitation skills

What is Required?

\$500 per person per Year
Four weekends per Year
Sign a learning agreement
Fully participate in all 8 sessions
Submit two written projects
Complete all readings
Pass the "models exam"
